

## Hepatobiliary (HPB) Surgery

Description of Services	Conditions seen include:
	<ul> <li>Gallstone disease (including bile duct stones and other complex problems)</li> <li>Incidental liver lesions</li> <li>Metastatic liver cancer, including colorectal liver metastases</li> <li>Primary liver cancer (HCC/Hepatoma)</li> <li>Benign liver lesions (FNH, haemangioma, adenoma, large cysts)</li> <li>Pancreas cancer</li> <li>Incidental pancreatic lesions (including IPMN and other pancreatic cysts)</li> <li>Complications from pancreatitis, including chronic pancreatitis</li> <li>Bile duct cancer</li> <li>Bile duct cysts and strictures</li> <li>Gallbladder cancer</li> </ul> The HPB Unit holds a fortnightly multidisciplinary cancer meeting to discuss and plan the treatment of patients with HPB cancers.
