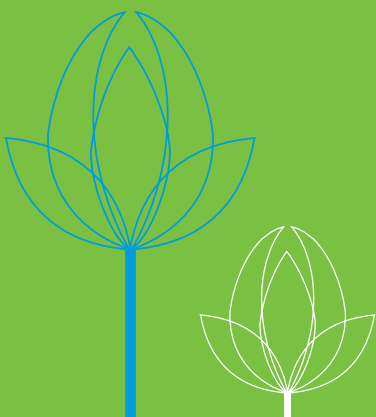

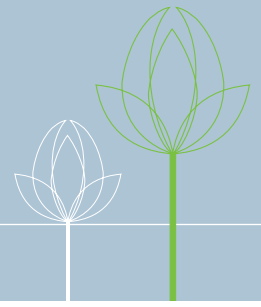


It's inspirational to see that the students chose to support our Day Oncology Appeal all by themselves without being influenced by their teachers. They really wanted to help a community that was a part of their own.

Kim Kennedy of Mill Park recently received a kidney transplant that was three years in the making! Receiving this much needed kidney was a life changing experience not only for her, but for her family. Kim received her pre and post-transplant care

at Northern Health and for three years spent over 12 hours a week with us which had an unimaginable impact on her daily life.

Receiving a kidney from an organ donor in June was a lifetime gift to Kim and her family. To celebrate Kim will host a Dinner Dance on Saturday, 9 December 2017 from 6:30 pm at Ferraro Receptions. The event will be the perfect way to celebrate your end of year with staff and family and an incredible cause with all proceeds going back to Dialysis Equipment at Northern Health. 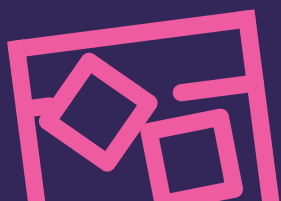

**Observation units -
\$1,790
16 Needed**



The need for observation monitors is essential to the daily work of the nurses on the medical wards. They allow nurses to take the blood pressure, temperature and respiratory rate of all patients. This is required on a four hourly basis.

WISH 2

**Air mattresses
and pumps - \$2,890
16 Needed**



Air mattresses are important to use with immobile patients who are often elderly, need palliative care, or have fragile skin. These patients have a high risk of pressure injury either due to weight or the converse, due to extreme weight loss and bone pressure against the skin for long periods of time. Many patients are also admitted with pressure injuries already.

**Princess Chairs for
patients <300 kg -
\$6,495
2 Needed**



Princess chairs are therapeutic chairs required for physically immobile patients to be able to be seated in a chair which will appropriately and safely support them, and enable them to be seated in a chair, without the risk of falling out. This chair caters for patients who have a weight of up to 300kg.

WISH 4

**Scalp Cooling machine -
\$50,000 2 needed**



The use of scalp cooling is proven to be an effective way of combatting chemotherapy induced hair loss and can result in a high level of retention or completely preserve the hair. For patients, this means the opportunity to regain some control, maintain their privacy and encourage a positive attitude towards treatment.
