How do I apply for a graduate position at Northern Health?

Follow the link from www.nh.org.au "work with us" and click "current job vacancies".

Follow the link to our eMercury careers portal. Find our 3 Programs by entering "graduate" into the search bar. Select the appropriate graduate position, and "sign up" to apply.

Follow the instructions and upload the required documents.

Do I need to certify my documents before I upload them?

No. You will be required to bring the original documents to your interview to verify authenticity.

Do I need to upload every page of my clinical appraisal documents?

Yes, please include all pages. We want to read both your interim and final appraisal of your 2 acute care placements.

I only have one acute care appraisal this year. Can I use one from last year?

We understand that it may be necessary in certain situations to provide 2nd year appraisal/s in your application. Your CV should list all undergraduate placements attended, so it will be clear to us what your options are.

What is the interview process?

You will be notified via email if you have been successful in gaining an interview. Interviews will be held in August, and you will be asked to select your own interview time from our online booking system. Northern Health will conduct what is commonly known as panel interviews, in a relaxed, friendly manner. These will generally involve 2 members of NH staff and one candidate. There are no other "tests involved.

When will I know if I have been successful?

Our education team will be excited to personally contact all successful candidates when PMCV releases the match results on Wednesday 9th October 2019.
