

Graduate Diploma in Midwifery

Our midwifery services at Northern Health provide care for women in one of Melbourne's most rapidly growing regions. These maternity services include care for women with both low and high risk pregnancies within a level 5 service capability and level 5 neonatal unit. Northern Health is committed to providing family centred care to our diverse community of women originating from over 40 different countries and speaking over 100 languages and their babies.

In 2021 Northern Health will be supporting this program in a clinical placement model in partnership with Latrobe University. This unpaid model, will allow student midwives to be fully supported in gaining experience across the entire pregnancy and birthing journey. A fully supernumerary model maximises student opportunities and learning experiences
