



# Cardiology Nursing

Our Cardiology Unit and Cath Lab are among the busiest in Victoria receiving 5,000 patients each year, including 2,000 patients presenting with acute myocardial infarction.

The Cardiology Unit operates a STEMI service 24/7 and admits both elective and emergency conditions.

We provide a range of cardiac diagnostic investigations and interventional procedures for patients with heart disease: pacemaker implantation, coronary angiography/stenting, electrophysiology studies, radio frequency ablation, fractional flow reserve studies, loop recorder insertion, ICD implantation, cardiac MRI, stress testing, temporary pacing wire insertion and telemetry monitoring.
