Medical Nursing is the foundation of your nursing career, providing you with the knowledge & skills to advance your future practice. Medical Nursing will advance your patient assessment skills enabling more meaningful and effective care planning for the individual patient and provides a good basis for ongoing re-evaluation of the patient and the effectiveness of treatment during their inpatient journey.

Medical Nursing is complex; challenging, and often patient conditions are not curative but managing chronic conditions signs & symptoms for a better quality of life. Medical Nursing has a diverse patient cohort, each patient will present with various care needs requiring nurses to expand their knowledge base throughout their careers.

In constructing specialist nursing knowledge and skills, students will evaluate care strategies that can be applied within the medical nursing setting.
