Northern Health Surgical Services Division provides care for the Northern community in a wide variety of surgical specialties.

Based across 2 campuses (Epping and Broadmeadows), Northern Health has 11 operating suites covering services in general surgery, orthopaedic, plastics, urology, gynaecology, obstetrics, paediatrics, ENT, hepatobiliary, vascular, thoracic, ophthalmology and endoscopy.

As Northern Health expands services, the new tower build (due to open in 2021), provides 3 new operating theatres at Epping, to ensure patient demand is met.
