





Renal Nursing

The Renal services at Northern Health provide care for patients across inpatient, outpatient and at home locations. Services are located at both Epping and Broadmeadows campuses.

Outpatient haemodialysis is provided to patients at the satellite units, while the Incentre Dialysis unit mainly provides haemodialysis to acute in-patients and to patients starting their first treatments. The Home Dialysis Training Unit works with patients requiring peritoneal dialysis or haemodialysis to prepare patients to have home-based treatment.
