Respiratory Nursing incorporates education of the patient and their carers for ongoing management at home. Discharge planning is vital from the time of admission.

Respiratory Nursing is complex; challenging, and often patient conditions are not curative but managing chronic conditions signs & symptoms for a better quality of life. Respiratory Nursing has a diverse patient cohort, each patient will present with various care needs requiring nurses to expand their knowledge base throughout their careers.
