

For the 2020/21 Graduate Nurse / Midwifery Program (GNMP) match there will be a new video interview process for all approved candidates to undertake.

Process

All approved candidates will be invited to conduct a video interview using Sonru software for the GNMP Match. This will be recorded via their desktop or via the Sonru mobile app for Android or iOS.

Timeline

Monday 10 th – Wednesday	GNMP Candidates do Live interviews using the Sonru software
12 th August 2020	(you can use SONRU anytime during these three days)

You will receive an email to register for Sonru as a participant in order to complete the interview. **Please** ensure that your email address on your PMCV match registration is correct. Once registered in Sonru you will undertake the specific interview that relates to your health service preference stream i.e.

- Nursing (includes all specialities and Collaborative programs),
- Midwifery,
- Combined Nursing Midwifery,
- Mental Health or Combined Nursing/Mental Health.

Preparation for the Live Interview

Before doing the Live interview, candidates will have the opportunity to do practice interviews between 10th - 12th August using SONRU software / app. Practice interviews are not submitted to health services for assessments.

Before you start the practice interviews, you will need to download the Sonru app:

To use Sonru on your laptop or desktop:

- Download latest version of flash player (https://get.adobe.com/flashplayer/npapiosx/)
- Test if flash is set up correctly for your browser https://get.adobe.com/flashplayer/about/ (note you should be able to see an animation of a bouncing square if correctly installed)
- Ensure all other videoconference software is turned off
- Allow your browser to access the microphone and camera

To use Sonru on your mobile, download from the Apple App store or Google Play store.

To ensure the best video result -

- Find a room with suitable lighting
- Check your interview connection
- Check your camera & microphone is working, especially if you are using your computer
- Ensure you dress appropriately, check your background and speak clearly!

Each candidate will complete one Live video interview based on the streams selected i.e. if you have selected Nursing and Combined Nursing/Midwifery you will have two sets of questions to respond to.

You need to record your Live interview in one sitting and once only before midnight on 12 August 2020. You cannot pause or restart once the recording has started. Just like a real interview!

There will be up to 5 questions to respond to within each interview stream. You will have 1-2 minutes to read each question, then approximately 2 minutes to respond.

It will look like this:

Your time to read each question.

Your time to **respond** to each question.

The health services you have in your preference list will have access to the completed videos from 20th August 2020. Please note: not all participating Health Services will use SONRU. They may use other online tools / platforms for conducting their interviews.
