Orthopaedic nurses are specialised nurses who work closely with patients and their families, providing complex clinical and holistic care, from pre-operative to post-operative management, to preparing patients and their families for discharge and beyond. Working within a wider multidisciplinary team, it is important that Orthopaedic nurses have the knowledge and confidence to interact in a collaborative and professional manner in order to care and advocate for healthcare consumers. Whether caring for elective or trauma orthopaedic patients, it is important for orthopaedic nurses to develop specialist nursing knowledge and advance their clinical skills if they are to deliver the best, evidence-based and person-centred care.

Working in a fast paced, ever changing environment, Orthopaedic nursing is a very exciting and rewarding career choice, with many opportunities for career advancement, from Clinical Nurse Specialist to Nurse Practitioner.
