



Rehabilitation Nursing

Rehabilitation Nursing is one part of an interdisciplinary team working together to aid patients to adapt physically and emotionally to lifestyle changes following illness or injury. Rehabilitation nurses participate 24/7 in treatment programs to assist in supporting the patient in achieving their rehabilitation goals.

Participation in a formal education program promotes development of advanced nursing assessment and management skills and enables provision of strong evidence-based patient focused care.

The Graduate Certificate in Clinical Rehabilitation will run in partnership with Flinders University in 2021
